The Company also acknowledges that health and safety is an integral part of its activities, policies, processes, and business operations.

Our OH&S strategy is rooted in our leadership ethos, driven by the following commitments and actions:

- Incidents and injuries are preventable. We shall adopt appropriate measures to focus on OH&S risks and opportunities for the prevention of occupation related incidents, injuries, illnesses, and near-misses.
- Set objectives and targets for OH&S, conduct reviews to assess performance and integrate these targets into business operations.
- Fulfil all applicable OH&S related statutory requirements and strive for "Beyond Compliance" leadership to implement industry best practices.
- Review the management systems periodically and provide adequate resources to promote reward & recognition programs and OH&S initiatives to ensure continual improvement.
- Ensure that all operational changes (temporary or permanent) are reviewed for potential health and safety impacts, and they are implemented with necessary risk control measures.
- Build OH&S awareness and competencies among employees at all levels enabling them to handle individual OH&S responsibilities and ensure adherence to applicable OH&S requirements, thereby creating a safe workplace.
- Engage with suppliers and contractors by proactively communicating the Company's OH&S Policy, objectives, targets and expectations, and encourage their alignment with our standards; thereby including their participation and consultation in the process.
- Communicate the OH&S Policy to employees and business partners of the Company and ensure that it is available to our stakeholders and the general public.
- Implement an effective emergency preparedness plan to manage and protect the Company's workforce in the event of any emergency scenario.

To ensure the adequacy of this OH&S Policy, the EOHS & Sustainability function of the Company shall review this Policy annually and update as necessary to deliver on the Company's OH&S commitments.
